Re: 12 New Positive COVID-19 Test Results in Hunt County and One New Death

12 new positive test results for COVID-19 have been reported in Hunt County, and one existing patient has passed away. The Hunt County Health Department completed an initial investigation and determined that the individuals in question reside in Hunt County. The general information for the 12 new patients is as follows:

Tracked Cases Number 238 and 290 are now hospitalized. Hospitalization of 290 is not related to COVID-19 complications but will be counted a "hospitalized patient with COVID-19" until recovery or discharge. Hunt County will release current hospitalization numbers in its morning report.

Also, Tracked Case Number 302 has unfortunately passed away due to COVID-19 complications.

Because three of the earlier Tracked Cases were either outside of the County or tested negative, there have been a total of 342 positive cases of Hunt County residents to date.

Each morning, the County will release and post on its website a new set of numbers and charts showing the total number of cases, including the status and ZIP Codes of those cases.
