Re: Eleven New Positive COVID-19 Test Results in Hunt County

Eleven new positive test results for COVID-19 have been reported in Hunt County. The Hunt County Health Department completed an initial investigation and determined that the individuals in question reside in Hunt County. The general information for the eleven new patients is as follows:

Tracked Case #125 – Male, aged 31-49, ZIP Code 75402, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #126 – Male, aged 50-64, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #127 – Male, aged 31-49, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #128 – Male, aged 0-17, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #129 – Female, aged 0-17, ZIP Code 75474, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #130 – Male, aged 31-49, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #131 – Female, aged 0-17, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #132 – Female, aged 0-17, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #133 – Female, aged 18-30, ZIP Code 75428, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #134 – Female, aged 18-30, ZIP Code 75402, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #135 – Female, aged 18-30, ZIP Code 75474, recovering at home.

Also, Tracked Case #123 is now hospitalized.

Because three of the earlier Tracked Cases were either outside of the County or tested negative, there have been a total of 132 positive cases of Hunt County residents to date.

Each morning, the County will release and post on its website a new set of numbers and charts showing the total number of cases, including the status and ZIP Codes of those cases.
