Re: Eight New Positive COVID-19 Test Results in Hunt County, and

Replacement of Two Prior Cases

Eight new positive test results for COVID-19 have been reported in Hunt County. The Hunt County Health Department completed an initial investigation and determined that the individuals in question reside in Hunt County. Two previously-reported cases are being removed from the County's tracking – Tracked Cases 82 and 85. It was determined that one of those cases lives just outside the County's limits, and the other has a different transmittable illness. These issues have been corrected in the state's records. The general information for the eight patients is as follows:

Tracked Case #82 (replacement of previous tracked case) – Female, aged 65+, ZIP Code 75474, in hospital;

Tracked Case #85 (replacement of previous tracked case) – Female, aged 0-17, ZIP Code 75474, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #86 – Female, aged 31-49, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #87 – Female, aged 50-64, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #88 – Male, aged 50-64, ZIP Code 75422, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #89 – Female, aged 18-30, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #90 – Female, aged 31-49, ZIP Code 75401, recovering at home;

Tracked Case #91 – Female, aged 31-49, ZIP Code 75474, recovering at home;

Each morning, the County will release and post on its website a new set of numbers and charts showing the total number of cases, including the status and ZIP Codes of those cases.
