

COMPLIANCE WITH HB 3693

The City of Commerce purchases natural gas from Atmos. In Calendar year 2012, the city purchased a total of 1495.9 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from Direct Energy. In Calendar Year 2012, the City purchased a total of 3,553,519 kilowatt hours. The City also purchases electricity from Farmer's Co-Op. In Calendar Year 2012, the City purchased a total of 817,500 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from the Sabine River Authority. In Calendar Year 2012, the City purchased a total of 385,726,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in Calendar Year 2012 is \$561,467.05.
